#### China's Potato as a Staple Food Strategy: History, Progress and Challenges

Peter is both a farmer and a recognized international practical potato scientist. Dr VanderZaag has worked intensively on potatoes with the International Potato

Center(CIP) both as a scientist in many countries and as a Board member including 4 years as the Chair of the Board.

Peter opened the CIP work in China back in 1986 and since then has seen an incredible transformation in all aspects of Chinese society and economy. Potato production has increased 6 fold since that time.
